



# COMMUNITY-BASED PARTNERSHIP MODEL

## 1 REQUEST

Indigenous entrepreneur or organization requests to become a partner



## 2 CONNECT

A Kairos KBE Partnership Coordinator will connect with the request

## 3 TOGETHER

Coordinator and new Partner will:

- sign agreement
- ensure fees are paid
- organize training



## 4 READY!

All KBEs/vKBEs will be organized and delivered by partners. Requests will be:

- directly received by partners
- directed to partners via Kairos\*



## 5 ONGOING

New KBE Indigenous Advisory Circle will:

- provide collaborative guidance
- help to:
  - update curriculum
  - update scripts

*\*KBEs/vKBEs will no longer be organized by Kairos, but rather by partners*

# NOTABLE CHANGES



## FACILITATORS

Kairos facilitators will either have to start their own business or become connected with current partners

They will organize the KBE from the beginning, instead of just showing up to facilitate.



## ACCEPTING KBE REQUESTS

Hosts requesting a KBE will either contact partners directly or we will funnel requests to partners from the point of the request.



## TRAINING

Training will include general training, as well as formal train-the-trainer sessions

Updates will be done with the new Indigenous Advisory Circle



## KAIROS' ROLE

We will focus on training new partners and resource development (ie. script updates).

We will step out of role in organizing KBEs. Partners will organize KBEs from the point of the request.
